- Parents of children aged 13 and under understand that we are using a 3rd party platform, Zoom, to conduct our tutoring sessions. Please refer to the Zoom terms and conditions available on their website for information relating to their specific platform.

Additional Code of Conduct for Tutors

- You agree to dress appropriately while conducting the tutoring session
- You agree to keep the background of your tutoring sessions free from all/any distractions and any inappropriate content.
- You agree to keep any personal information shared by the tutee confidential.
- You agree to conduct yourself professionally and in case of any disagreement(s), refer the tutee or the parent/guardian to email learnwithpeer@gmail.com.
- You agree to inform the Learn With Peers, Inc Founder or Volunteer Manager if your unweighted GPA falls below 3.5 or if the school takes any disciplinary action against you.
- You agree that if Learn With Peers, Inc receives any complaint concerning your misconduct with the tutee during the online tutoring session, Learn With Peers, Inc may take disciplinary action against you including revoking the service hours and/or removal from the team.
